
- Expanded <u>AFMA Across East</u>, <u>West & Central</u> Africa.

- Convened <u>134 women in leadership law</u> from 20 countries, launched the <u>Women in Leadership in Law</u>
 <u>Media Toolkit</u>, and delivered a media masterclass.
- Trained 100+ FEMNET members on digital security, media advocacy, African human rights systems, and resisting anti-rights offensives during our programing conference and general assembly.
- Convened the first EU-Kenya CSO Forum, bringing together over 100 diverse Kenyan CSOs, and launched 14 community-based organisations (CBOs) from 18 counties. The CBOs will receive funding support to advance their work.

UNMUTED Campaign!

UNMUTE Campaign! This was HUGE! During 16 Days of Activism (Nov-Dec 2025), we amplified survivors' voices, culminating in a powerful digital campaign and photo exhibition that spotlighted gender-based violence.

Feminist Leaders from 17 African countries convened to strengthen collective power to end violence against women and girls across Africa, in our flagship African Feminist Leadership Academy

Collated and synthesized feedback for the African Feminist Sexual and Reproductive Health & Rights Charter with 40 participants and 24 organizations committing to integrate it into Beijing+30 national advocacy. Be on the lookout for more information on this revolutionary charter in 2026!

Convened the African Feminist Just
Transition Forum during the Africa
Climate Summit in Addis Ababa. Together,
we developed the African Feminist Just
Transition Position Paper, amplifying
women and girls' priorities and advocating
for feminist climate justice integration
into the final Addis Ababa Declaration.



GIRLS & YOUNG WOMEN AS THE MAIN CHARACTER



Mali Girls & Young Women
Shaping SRHR & GBV Policy

Supported girls and young women from Mali to move from beneficiaries to recognized policy actors, jointly drafting and submitting a memorandum on reproductive health, child marriage, and GBV to national decision-makers.

Launched the Climate Change Awards in Mali, a youth-led digital campaign reaching 17,800+ young people, spotlighting the climate emergency and its links to gender equality.

Gaborone hosted the 4th Africa Disrupt (25–27 Feb. 2025) under the theme: "Beijing+30 Uniting in Solidarity, Safeguarding Our Gains, Amplifying Our Voices." Over 60 women and girls came together to shape Africa CSW69 Recommendations for revitalizing the CSW.

In the AU year of reparations and justice for Africa, FEMENT led an African feminist paper on reparations in Malabo, a Youth charter on reparations, and a webinar on reparations – the struggle for justice continues.
